The Dee Ivy Scholarship

This year, 2011, the Dee Ivy Scholarship Fund will award three \$475 scholarships. Recipients of the Ivy Scholarships shall be college students, seminary students, or other graduate students preparing for a full-time church related vocation in The United Methodist Church. Recipients shall have established a worthy academic record and demonstrated commitment to Jesus Christ through the values, behavior and leadership they have demonstrated.

Undergraduate recipients shall have achieved the classification of Junior or Senior in their academic hours completed and be enrolled in their final one or two years of undergraduate studies. A student enrolled at any academic level of graduate study in a seminary in good standing with the United Methodist University Senate or other graduate school accredited in the area of study in which the student is enrolled may be eligible.

Recipients shall be members of The United Methodist Church and have experience in having been involved in at least one United Methodist congregation. They will have home or current membership in a United Methodist congregation in the New Mexico Conference and their intent is to pursue full-time church-related vocation within the bounds of the New Mexico Conference. Variance from this guideline may be made by the Scholarship Committee in consideration of applicants.
